

Both are connected to the same network via Ethernet. I had installed ms sql 2008 in my older PC which had a firewall of 10.0.2530. The firewall is not on in the laptop. I have setup my new laptop as a domain controller and the new laptop has access to the same drive on the domain as the old PC. The old PC is acting as a print server. My goal is to keep the firewall on my new laptop so that any one at my office can connect to the printers and then access

the old PC. My problem is that when I try to connect to the old PC from the new laptop, I get the same error in outlook the File cannot be opened because it is being used by another process. You may not have permission to access the file. Do I need to turn off firewall on the new laptop if so how do I do it and what do I need to do to get the old PC accessible through the new laptop.
